### Fees Per Day:

Rate for four (4) people. \$4 per additional person per night. Payment by cash or credit card, no checks. All fees due at check-in.

## Park Regulations

- Check-in 12 p.m. (noon) / Check-out 11 a.m.
- Cancellation Policy: Please call 24 hours before you are scheduled to arrive if you need to cancel or change your reservation. If you do not call, your credit card will be charged for one full night's stay and the rest of your reservation cancelled.
- Speed Limit: 5 mph (please inform any guests)
- Quiet Hours: 10 p.m. - 7 a.m. Please be considerate of your neighbors. Disorderly conduct, drunkenness, illegal drugs, obscene language, loud music, obnoxious, disruptive or vulgar behavior not tolerated.
- Guests Policy: Only one car per site. Guests must park outside RV park. You are responsible for getting your guests in and out of the park once the gate is closed.
- Always supervise your children and your guests' children. Do not allow children near the riverbank.
- The dumpster near the restrooms is for personal trash only. Garbage must be bagged and tied. **Do NOT leave trash outside RVs.** Sites must be kept clean and orderly.
- Up to three pets allowed per RV. All pets must always be on a leash and never left unattended outside (city ordinance). Pit bull dog breeds are banned in North Little Rock (city ordinance). Pet waste stations are available, and **are not to be used for personal trash.** Failure to pick up after your pet(s) or pets causing a disturbance or harm can result in dismissal from the park.
- No generators are allowed to be run.
- Tent camping prohibited. No parking in vacant sites.
- Stay limited to 14 days unless otherwise approved by Management.
- No fireworks, bottle rockets or ground fires are allowed in the RV park (city ordinance). Discharging of firearms or any explosives is prohibited and illegal.
- 24 hour coin operated laundry available on site.
- Please pre-pay for purchasing bags of ice. Vehicle or RV washing permitted for an additional fee.
- No dumping grey water or black tank on ground; a fine will be imposed by the EPA.
- Please use caution when walking along riverbanks. Swimming in the Arkansas River is prohibited from within the park. Arkansas state licenses required for fishing.

Argenta Arts District: Dining, entertainment, events.

Argenta Plaza: large community space with water and light features.

Arkansas River Trail: 7-mile walking and cycling trail.

Clinton Presidential Center: Access via Clinton Pedestrian Bridge.

Dickey-Stephens Park: AA baseball, one mile west.

North Little Rock Heritage Center: local history.

Rock Region METRO Streetcars: scenic loop with stops in downtown North Little Rock and Little Rock.

Rock Town River Outfitters: bike and kayak rentals.

Simmons Bank Arena: large concert venue within walking distance.

The Old Mill at T. R. Pugh Memorial Park: replica of an 1800s grist-mill surrounded by a beautiful park. Free.

WWII Submarine & Tugboat: .5-mile west inside seawall.
